### **Bra79. Edmondsey Wood (9.6 ha) TL 760306**

Edmondsey Wood has a canopy of Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) and Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) over neglected Small-leaved Lime (*Tilia cordata*) and Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*) coppice and invasive Sycamore (*Acer pseudoplatanus*). Part of the wood has been replanted with conifers. The ground flora is rich in ancient woodland plants, such as Yellow Archangel (*Lamium galeobdolon*), Wood Anemone (*Anemone nemorosa*), Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*), Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*), Three-veined Sandwort (*Moehringia trinervia*) and Primrose (*Primula vulgaris*).
