The light soil here supports a scarce floral assemblage, which is notable for the presence of Meadow Saxifrage (*Saxifraga granulata*). Other frequent species include Field Wood-rush (*Luzula campestris*), Red Fescue (*Festuca rubra*), Sweet Vernal Grass (*Anthoxanthum odoratum*), Common Bent-grass (*Agrostis capillaris*), Meadow Foxtail (*Alopecurus pratensis*) and Mouse-ear Hawkweed (*Hieracium pilosella*).
