Bra161. Greenwood Spring East (2.6 ha), TL 813267

Greenwood Spring is an area of wood adjoining the Broadfield and Belchers Wood SSSI. Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*), with scattered Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) and Birch (*Betula* sp.) dominate the composition of this wood. Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) and Hawthorn (*Crataegus monogyna*) form a sparse understorey layer. The currently poor ground flora is typified by the presence of Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*), Creeping Soft-grass (*Holcus mollis*) and Three-veined Sandwort (*Moehringia trinervia*).
