Bra72. Hazelton Wood (23.6 ha) TL 757185

This large ancient wood has a diverse canopy composition, with much Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*), Aspen (*Populus tremula*), Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*), Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) and Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*). Field Maple (*Acer campestre*), Wych Elm (*Ulmus glabra*) and Alder (*Alnus glutinosa*) occur more sparingly. The rich ground flora includes Tufted Hair-grass (*Deschampsia cespitosa*), Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*), Pendulous Sedge (*Carex pendula*), Creeping Jenny (*Lysimachia nummularia*) and Primrose (*Primula vulgaris*).
