### **Bra22. Moyns Park (61.6 ha) TL 694404**

Moyns Park is a large area of partially improved grassland with a varied mix of grasses, such as Sweet Vernal Grass (*Anthoxanthum odoratum*), Quaking Grass (*Briza media*), Crested Dog's-tail (*Cynosurus cristatus*), Yellow Oat-grass (*Trisetum flavescens*) and Meadow Barley (*Hordeum secalinum*). Throughout the park there are many Cowslips (*Primula veris*). The scattered tree cover adds to both the wildlife interest and landscape appeal of this site.

The wooded area of Maze Plantation is located to the south of the grassland. The canopy of this wood comprises mainly Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*), Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) and Sycamore (*Acer pseudoplatanus*) over Hazel (*Corylus avellana*). The varied ground flora includes Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*), Pendulous Sedge (*Carex pendula*), Hairy St. John's-wort (*Hypericum hirsutum*) and Creeping Jenny (*Lysimachia nummularia*).
