Bra200. Waldegrave Wood (8.9 ha) TL 844368

The structure of this ancient wood is mainly Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) and Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) standards, with Silver Birch (*Betula pendula*), and Elm (*Ulmus* sp.), over a Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) coppice, Hawthorn (*Crataegus monogyna*) and Elder (*Sambucus nigra*) shrub layer. Among the ground flora are Wood Anemone (*Anemone nemorosa*), Wood Sorrel (*Oxalis acetosella*), Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*) and Primrose (*Primula vulgaris*).
