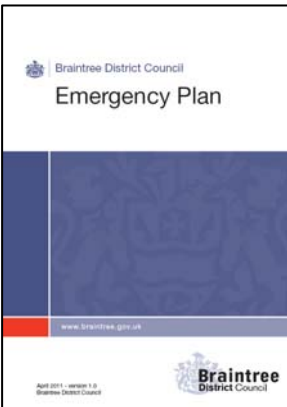

  - Emergency Planning is the process of planning, preparing, training etc to ensure that the Council can respond to any emergency that arises in the District

  - Etc



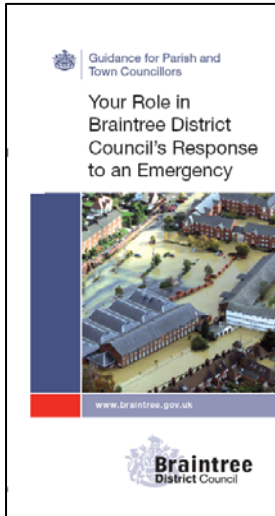

  - Vulnerable People information
    - This is helpful for you to know as well – this helps to identify where you may have pressures/risks in your Parish

    - This is important to know, as the Police or Fire Service may evacuate residents
  - Contact details
    - Who should BDC call in the first instance to alert you to an emergency?
