

## Fly tip Prosecutions 15<sup>th</sup> June 2009

A resident of Mitchell Avenue, Halstead was summonsed to Chelmsford magistrates Court on 15<sup>th</sup> June 2009 for depositing a trailer full of waste in Nuntys Wood between Pattiswick and Burtons Green, Halstead. The waste comprised car parts, a children's paddling pool, a rotary washing line and a selection of domestic waste.

In court he pleaded guilty to the charges, the magistrates ordered the defendant to pay a fine and costs of £914.00. This included a sum to allow for the removal and disposal of the waste in the proper manner. The prosecution followed a thorough and probing investigation by the Environmental Protection Officer into the circumstances of the deposit.
