Bra69. Runalong Wood (7.2 ha) TL 756327

Runalong Wood contains two distinctly contrasting stand types. To the north, Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*) coppice abounds, whilst to the south Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) predominates, along with much Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*), Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) and Field Maple (*Acer campestre*). Wild Service Tree (*Sorbus torminalis*) is also present. The rather modest ground flora includes frequent Enchanter's Nightshade (*Circaea lutetiana*) and Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*), with some Wood Sorrel (*Oxalis acetosella*), Creeping Jenny (*Lysimachia nummularia*), Creeping Soft-grass (*Holcus mollis*) and Primrose (*Primula vulgaris*).
