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Bra9. Bridge End Meadows (2.6 ha) TL 676307

This site comprises two meadows along the bank of the River Pant. The western meadow has a mix of vegetation types. A wet streamside area supports Marsh Marigold (*Caltha palustris*), Ragged Robin (*Lychnis flos-cuculi*), Meadowsweet (*Filipendula ulmaria*) and Cuckooflower (*Cardamine pratensis*). This grades into taller, less species-rich swards on drier ground where Meadow Foxtail (*Alopecurus pratensis*), Sweet Vernal Grass (*Anthoxanthum odoratum*) and Cock's-foot (*Dactylis glomerata*) are the main grass species. The eastern meadow, whilst not as species diverse, provides valuable additional riverside grassland habitat.
