Bra140. Paines Manor Lane Road Verge (0.2 ha), TL 799441

This roadside verge site retains a diversity and richness in its flora, which today is often lost from meadows due to improvement. The east side, with a large bank provides a small niche where many herbs flourish. Species include Sulphur Clover (*Trifolium ochroleucon*), Lady's Bedstraw (*Galium verum*), Primrose (*Primula vulgaris*), Wild Basil (*Clinopodium vulgare*), Burnet saxifrage (*Pimpinella saxifraga*), Restharrow (*Ononis repens*) and Cowslip (*Primula veris*).
