Bra64. Sandy Wood (18.4 ha) TL 752153

This large ancient wood has been somewhat disturbed by storm damage and replanting with both broadleaved and coniferous trees. The native canopy and understorey comprises Small-leaved Lime (*Tilia cordata*), Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*), Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*), Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*), Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) and Midland Hawthorn (*Crataegus laevigata*). Sweet Chestnut (*Castanea sativa*) is also frequent. The ground flora includes much Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*), Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*), Wood Sage (*Teucrium scorodonia*) and Wood Spurge (*Euphorbia amygdaloides*).
