Bra136. Belchamp St Paul Orchard (1.5 ha) TL 796424

Orchard sites, now rare in the county, are important for supporting mammal, bird and invertebrate populations. They also provide a resource of old local fruit varieties, many of which have disappeared from production. Fruit tree species present include Apple (*Malus* sp.) and Plum (*Prunus* sp.). Sycamore (*Acer pseudoplatanus*) was planted in the early part of the twentieth century.
