**Bra90. Cuckoo Hill Wood (1.2 ha) TL 766342**

This small, possibly ancient wood has a canopy/sub canopy of Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*), Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*), coppiced Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*) and Hazel (*Corylus avellana*), with a scrub layer, which includes Hawthorn (*Crataegus monogyna*), Elder (*Sambucus nigra*) and Holly (*Ilex aquifolium*). The northern section of the wood 'thins out' to become fairly open in places. The ground flora typically comprises Bramble (*Rubus fruticosus* agg), Bracken (*Pteridium aquilinum*), Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*) and Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*).
