Bra157. Park House Meadow (2.7 ha) TL 810223

This predominantly well-drained meadow is typified by the presence of Sweet Vernal Grass (*Anthoxanthum odoratum*), Crested Dog's-tail (*Cynosurus cristatus*), Velvet Bent-grass (*Agrostis canina*), Red Fescue (*Festuca rubra*), Yellow Oat-grass (*Trisetum flavescens*) and Yorkshire Fog (*Holcus lanatus*). A typical assemblage of herbs includes Lady's Bedstraw (*Galium verum*).
