Bra239. Alphasstone Complex (7.6 ha) TL 874355

This site contains a very varied suite of habitats, ranging from dry grassland in an old gravel pit, scrub, wet Alder (*Alnus glutinosa*) woodland and swamp. The flora has a notable quantity of Alternate-leaved Golden-saxifrage (*Chrysosplenium alternifolium*), which is now rare in the county. Other species recorded include Marsh Marigold (*Caltha palustris*) and Opposite-leaved Golden-saxifrage (*Chrysosplenium oppositifolium*), along with Moschatel (*Adoxa moschatellina*), Lesser Pond Sedge (*Carex acutiformis*), Giant Horsetail (*Equisetum telmateia*) and Meadowsweet (*Filipendula ulmaria*).
