**Bra204. "Stream Strip", Colne Engaine (0.3 ha) TL 846305**

This narrow streamside woodland, probably an ancient woodland relic, has a very rich flora for such a small site. The canopy comprises Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*), Wych Elm (*Ulmus glabra*) and Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*), over Elder (*Sambucus nigra*) and Hawthorn (*Crataegus monogyna*). The ground flora includes Yellow Archangel (*Lamiastrum galeobdolon*), Ramsons (*Allium ursinum*), Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*), Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*), Pendulous Sedge (*Carex pendula*) and Wood Melick (*Melica uniflora*).
