Bra114. Long Wood Complex (8.7 ha) TL 783106

This site comprises Long Wood, Brewhouse Wood, Bishop's Wood and Sandpit Wood. Whilst little detailed information is available, the woods generally comprise a canopy/subcanopy of Sweet Chestnut (*Castanea sativa*), Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*), Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) and Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) with much Hawthorn (*Crataegus monogyna*) and Hazel (*Corylus avellana*). The ground flora is moderately rich in ancient woodland plants, with an abundance of Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*) and Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*), with Wood Spurge (*Euphorbia amygdaloides*) and Primrose (*Primula vulgaris*) also present.
