Bra8. Bushy Grove (4.2 ha) TL 675374

Bushy Grove comprises two rather different sections. To the north is a possibly ancient wood of old Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*), Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) and Field Maple (*Acer campestre*) coppice with large Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) standards, whilst to the south is a square of younger, more even aged wood of Oak, Hornbeam, Sweet Chestnut (*Castanea sativa*), Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) and Hazel. The northern section has the richer flora, with much Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*), Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*) and Hairy St. John's-wort (*Hypericum hirsutum*).
