Bra208. Raynor's Wood (4.8 ha) TL 848253

This ancient wood has a canopy of Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) standards over Sweet Chestnut (*Castanea sativa*), Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) and Sycamore (*Acer pseudoplatanus*). Old coppice stools of Small-leaved Lime (*Tilia cordata*) occur on the northern boundary. The understorey is mainly Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) and Elder (*Sambucus nigra*). The rather sparse ground flora is characterised by Bramble (*Rubus fruticosus* agg), Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*) and Creeping Soft-grass (*Holcus mollis*).
