Bra120. Troys Wood (18.5 ha) TL 785168

Troys Wood mainly comprises areas of old Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*) coppice, Hazel (*Corylus avellana*), standards of Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*), Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) and some planted conifers. A varied shrub layer includes Midland Hawthorn (*Crataegus laevigata*), Spindle Tree (*Euonymus europaeus*), Guelder Rose (*Viburnum opulus*) and Dogwood (*Cornus sanguinea*). Pendulous Sedge (*Carex pendula*), Wood Sedge (*Carex sylvatica*), Tufted Hair-grass (*Deschampsia cespitosa*) and Primrose (*Primula vulgaris*) are found in the ground flora.
