Bra234. Feering Marsh (4.0 ha) TL 871202

Located between the River Blackwater and the main London Railway line, this site consists of two zones: a Sedge (*Carex* spp.) bed to the south and Reed Canary-grass (*Phalaris arundinacea*) marsh to the north. Typical species characteristic of this habitat include Lesser Pond Sedge (*Carex acutiformis*), Greater Tussock Sedge (*C. paniculata*), Meadowsweet (*Filipendula ulmaria*), Floating Sweet-grass (*Glyceria fluitans*), Common Reed (*Phragmites australis*) and Bulrush (*Typha latifolia*).
