### **Bra229. Brockwell Meadows (part LNR) (9.3 ha) TL 866185**

To the east side of the River Blackwater, this site comprises former floodplain meadows, designated as part of the Local Nature Reserve (LNR), with some areas being managed to improve their wildlife value. A typical range of grassland plants can be found, with Meadowsweet (*Filipendula ulmaria*), Greater Pond Sedge (*Carex riparia*), Angelica (*Angelica sylvestris*) and Purple Loosestrife (*Lythrum salicaria*) occurring in damper areas. The remainder of the site lies outside the LNR. Here, plantation and marsh borders the river, providing an extensive band of habitat on the south east side of Kelvedon.

**Selection Criteria:** HCr13, HCr23, HCr27, SCr13
