#### **Bra34. Rumley Wood (3.2 ha) TL 710238**

Over half of the ancient Rumley Wood has been grubbed out, leaving a copse of Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*), Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*), Hazel (*Corylus avellana*), Hawthorn (*Crataegus monogyna*) and Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*). A few Scots pine (*Pinus sylvestris*) standards were also recorded. The rather poor ground flora is dominated by Nettle (*Urtica dioica*) and Bramble (*Rubus fruticosus* agg), though with some Yellow Archangel (*Lamium galeobdolon*), Pendulous Sedge (*Carex pendula*) and Meadowsweet (*Filipendula ulmaria*).
