Bra71. Hookley Wood (1.9 ha) TL 757165

This small ancient wood has a varied canopy and ground flora composition. Whilst Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) predominates, there is also much Small-leaved Lime (*Tilia cordata*), Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*), Hazel (*Corylus avellana*), Field Maple (*Acer campestre*) and Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*). The shrub layer comprises Midland Hawthorn (*Crataegus laevigata*), Elder (*Sambucus nigra*), Dogwood (*Cornus sanguinea*), Holly (*Ilex aquifolium*) and Guelder Rose (*Viburnum opulus*). The ground cover, though dominated by Bramble (*Rubus fruticosus* agg) and Ivy (*Hedera helix*), retains a varied composition.
