Bra203. Ash Bottom (2.9 ha) TL 846284

This stream valley wood is dominated by Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) and Sweet Chestnut (*Castanea sativa*) coppice with standards of Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) and invasive Sycamore (*Acer pseudoplatanus*) over Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) and Hawthorn (*Crataegus monogyna*). Alder (*Alnus glutinosa*) is occasional along the stream. The rich ground flora includes Moschatel (*Adoxa moschatellina*), Wood Anemone (*Anemone nemorosa*), Pendulous Sedge (*Carex pendula*), Opposite-leaved Golden-saxifrage (*Chrysosplenium oppositifolium*), Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*) and Primrose (*Primula vulgaris*).
