Bra66. Brickhouse Wood (4.2 ha) TL 755166

Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*) coppice dominates this ancient wood, whilst Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*), Silver Birch (*Betula pendula*) and Field Maple (*Acer campestre*) are also found throughout. The generally damp soil conditions support large quantities of Soft Rush (*Juncus effusus*), Tufted Hair-grass (*Deschampsia cespitosa*) and Marsh Thistle (*Cirsium palustre*) along with some Primrose (*Primula vulgaris*), Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*) and Sweet Violet (*Viola odorata*).
