Bra219. Twinsteadhall Wood (22.2 ha) TL 858357

This is a large ancient wood comprising a mix of broadleaved and coniferous species. The northern section has Birch (*Betula* sp.), Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) and old Sweet Chestnut (*Castanea sativa*) coppice while the south is mainly planted Scots Pine (*Pinus sylvestris*). Ground flora species include Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*), Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*), Wood Anemone (*Anemone nemorosa*) and Yellow Pimpernel (*Lysimachia nemorum*).
