Bra110. Templeborder Wood (3.4 ha) TL 782230

The northern wing of this wood comprises mainly Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) standards over Hazel (*Corylus avellana*), whereas the southern portion is largely Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*). Other canopy/subcanopy species include Holly (*Ilex aquifolium*), Field Maple (*Acer campestre*), Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) and Sweet Chestnut (*Castanea sativa*). The scrub layer is principally Hawthorn (*Crataegus monogyna*), Midland Hawthorn (*C. laevigata*), Elder (*Sambucus nigra*) and Blackthorn (*Prunus spinosa*). The ground flora is moderately rich and includes Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*), Sweet Violet (*Viola odorata*), Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*) and Goldilocks Buttercup (*Ranunculus auricomus*).
