1.BACKGROUND

1.1 Mr Darren Bugbee had applied for the renewal of his Street Trading consent to enable him to sell Christmas cards, greeting cards, Christmas gifts, wrapping paper and gift accessories from a stall in New Street, Braintree opposite Going Places throughout the month of December.

1.2 The hours Mr Bugbee has proposed to trade are set out below:

Monday 07:00 to 16:00
Tuesday 07:00 to 16:00
Thursday 07:00 to 16:00
Friday 07:00 to 16:00

Trading between the 1st December and 24th December 2006.

1.3 Following the necessary consultation It should be stressed to members that, following Mr Bugbee's similar application to trade and his subsequent trading in December 2005 a number complaints where received by the licensing department.

1.4 The complaints where mainly issues raised in relation to the proximity of the stall in relation to retail premises dealing in similar goods. Bearing this in mind it is likely that the licensing department is to receive similar complaints from Braintree Town Centre traders association, Hedingham Models and Collectables, Braintree Chamber of Commerce and ward members should the application be approved.

1.5 There have been no representations made from Essex Police, Essex County Council, Forward Plans or Ward Members in connection with the application.
