

Dog Control Order

A resident of Acorn Avenue, Halstead was summonsed to appear before Chelmsford Magistrates Court on 15th June 2009 as her dog, a fell terrier had bitten and injured a neighbour on two separate occasions. The neighbour suffered bites requiring medical attention to his upper arm in both October 2008 and April 2009

In court she pleaded guilty to the complaint and the Magistrates placed a Control Order on the dog under the Dogs Act 1871. She was also ordered to pay £300 towards the costs of Braintree District Council.
