This mixed habitat site of grassland, marsh and a small lake is situated adjacent to the River Stour. A very rich and diverse flora is to be found within, including Large Bittercress (*Cardamine amara*), Viper's-bugloss (*Echium vulgare*), Ragged Robin (*Lychnis flos-cuculi*), Yellow-rattle (*Rhinanthus minor*), Common Valerian (*Valeriana officinalis*) and Vervain (*Verbena officinalis*).

Selection Criteria: HCr5, HCr10, SCr13
