Executive Summary:-

On 28 June 2006 a petition was received by Housing Services (Witham management area) alleging anti-social behaviour by a family in Cornel Close, Witham. The petition was signed by 19 residents and 2 frequent visitors to the Close. The petition referred to damage caused to garages, gardens and motor vehicles resulting from over-zealous ball games and disregard for the care of residents' property. One family was identified as being responsible for the nuisance.

Options

The Estate Manager has interviewed the mother of the youths. She is a tenant of Braintree District Council. She has been reminded of her obligations under the Terms and Conditions of tenancy and that the Conditions apply to not only herself but members of her family. The affect on the security of her tenure and the implications of an ABC should the nuisance continue have also been notified to her both verbally and in writing. The lead petitioner has been informed in writing of the Council's action.
