Bra94. Lost Wood (18.6 ha) TL 769125

This large ancient wood is being commercially exploited for timber production, with extensive plantations of Beech (*Fagus sylvatica*), Scots Pine (*Pinus sylvestris*), Larch (*Larix* sp.) and Spruce (*Picea* sp.). Species native to the site include Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*), Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*), Field Maple (*Acer campestre*), Hazel (*Corylus avellana*), Elder (*Sambucus nigra*) and Hawthorn (*Crataegus monogyna*). Many ruderals are present in the flora, reflecting the disturbance due to forestry operations, though Bluebells (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*) are still widespread.
