Bra162. Chestnut Grove (4.3 ha) TL 813332

The northern section of Chestnut Grove is dominated by Sweet Chestnut (*Castanea sativa*), with some Hazel (*Corylus avellana*), Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*), Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) and Larch (*Larix* sp.). The ground flora has a fine display of Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*), Moschatel (*Adoxa moschatellina*), Red Campion (*Silene dioica*) and Wood Anemone (*Anemone nemorosa*). The larger southern section has much Hazel, Oak, Ash and, additionally, Elder (*Sambucus nigra*), Alder (*Alnus glutinosa*), Holly (*Ilex aquifolium*), Wild Cherry (*Prunus avium*) and Spruce (*Picea* sp.). The ground flora is similar to the north section.
