

Extract of the minutes of the meeting of the Scrutiny Panel held on 7th March 2007.

52 **REVIEW OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SCRUTINY PANEL'S
RECOMMENDATIONS SINCE 2003**

INFORMATION: Members considered a report on the progress to date with regard to the implementation of the Panel's recommendations since 2003. It was noted that the Panel had already considered this report in detail and this final version captured all the comments made to date.

The Scrutiny Manager considered that it would be beneficial if the Panel was to review the progress of the implementation of the recommendations on a rolling basis rather than at the end of the four year term. In response to a question by the Chair, the Scrutiny Manager advised that this would not have any resource implications.

On discussing the report, it was noted that there was work in progress with Trading Standards on the issue of cars for sale on grass verges which was welcomed by the Panel. The Panel was also advised that the anti-graffiti drive was moving forward with a launch next week.

DECISION:- That it be **recommended to Cabinet**

- (1) That the report be received and noted;
- (2) That, for all subsequent Scrutiny Panel recommendations, the relevant Cabinet Member[s] should submit to the Panel a progress report on the implementation within nine months of the Cabinet accepting the Panel's recommendations. Subsequent progress reports are to be submitted to the Panel upon request pending full implementation of the recommendations.
