Bra33. Flitch Way (9.2 ha) TL 710220 to TL 759227

The disused railway line west of Braintree has developed into a valuable wildlife site and corridor. Thick hedges generally bound the track, with grassland forming a central "woodland ride" and other areas where the hedges thin. Species of interest amongst the very diverse flora include Wall Rue (*Asplenium ruta-muraria*), Yellow-wort (*Blackstonia perfoliata*), Lesser Calamint (*Clinopodium calamintha*), Small Toadflax (*Chaenorhinum minus*), Small-flowered Crane's-bill (*Geranium pusillum*) and Flattened Meadow-grass (*Poa compressa*).
