Bra209. Spoon's Hall (4.8 ha) TL 848330

This stream valley site comprises open water, tall swamp, scrub and wood, which support a very rich flora and fauna. Many scarce Essex plants may be found, including Marsh Marigold (*Caltha palustris*), Ragged Robin (*Lychnis flos-cuculi*), Creeping Jenny (*Lysimachia nummularia*), Betony (*Stachys officinalis*) and Marsh Ragwort (*Senecio aquaticus*), a very rare plant and declining in Essex.
