Bra77. Galleycable Wood (2.8 ha) TL 758173

This ancient woodland remnant is composed of neglected coppice of Small-leaved Lime (*Tilia cordata*), Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*) and Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) with Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) and Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) standards. The understorey is mainly Elder (*Sambucus nigra*), Hawthorn (*Crataegus monogyna*), Elm (*Ulmus* spp.) and Spindle Tree (*Euonymus europaeus*). The ground cover is dominated by Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*).
