Bra11. Great Bardfield Marsh (2.8 ha) TL 677303

This site primarily comprises an area of streamside grassland. However, streamside Alder (*Alnus glutinosa*) provides for a more diverse habitat. The wetter areas along the stream channel have species of interest including Marsh Marigold (*Caltha palustris*) and Large Bittercress (*Cardamine amara*). The meadow is part grazed, with the lower slopes fenced off, where a tall grass sward dominates. Pignut (*Conopodium majus*) is plentiful in the grassland, whilst Cuckooflower (*Cardamine pratensis*) found in damper lower slope areas.
