Bra96. Terling Hall Woods (2.8 ha) TL 771130

These two woods, possibly both ancient, have canopies dominated by Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*), Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) and Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*), with many other woody species present in lesser amounts. Historically, these woods appear to have a connection with Lost Wood (Bra92) to the southeast
