**Bra232. Aldercar/ Shrive's Wood (10.2 ha) TL 869304**

This stream valley woodland, incorporating a small lake, has a canopy of Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*), Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) and Sycamore (*Acer pseudoplatanus*) over Holly (*Ilex aquifolium*), Elder (*Sambucus nigra*), Field Maple (*Acer campestre*) and many other woody species in small quantities. The varied ground flora includes Meadowsweet (*Filipendula ulmaria*), Pendulous Sedge (*Carex pendula*) and Ramsons (*Allium ursinum*).

Little information is available for Shrive's Wood. This ancient wood has a canopy dominated by young Pedunculate Oak and Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) with some planted Scots Pine (*Pinus sylvestris*). The ground flora is rather poor.
