Bra153. Moat Wood (19.2 ha) TL 806273

This is a large ancient wood displaying a variety of stand types, composed of Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*), Sweet Chestnut (*Castanea sativa*), Small-leaved Lime (*Tilia cordata*), Beech (*Fagus sylvatica*), Field Maple (*Acer campestre*), Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*), Wild Cherry (*Prunus avium*) and Silver Birch (*Betula pendula*). Species found among the ground flora include Pendulous Sedge (*Carex pendula*), Wood Melick (*Melica uniflora*), Yellow Archangel (*Lamium galeobdolon*), Remote Sedge (*Carex remota*) and Sanicle (*Sanicula europaea*).
