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Bra91. Mill Park Drive Wetland (0.7 ha), TL 767223

Sandwiched between housing, this small area habitat probably survives due to it being a predominantly wet area, unsuitable for development. Areas such as this provide valuable 'wild' refuges in the urban landscape. Here a central sedge bed of Lesser Pond-sedge (*Carex acutiformis*), is bounded by scrub and streamside trees. Tall Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) and Oak (*Quercus robur*) line the west side of the sedge bed, whilst Alder (*Alnus glutinosa*) and Crack Willow (*Salix fragilis*) line the stream channel near the wiers. Other species recorded from the site include Meadowsweet (*Filipendula ulmaria*) and Gypsywort (*Lycopus europaeus*). Indian Balsam (*Impatiens glandulifera*) is establishing in the locality.
