Bra17. St Peter and St Paul Churchyard, Bardfield Saling, (0.3 ha) TL686265,

This small village churchyard exhibits old grassland that has not been improved to any great extent. The flora reflects the influence of an underlying calcareous soil. The east side of the church displays the richest flora. Among the grass species to be found are Meadow Barley (*Hordeum secalinum*) and Yellow Oat-grass (*Trisetum flavescens*). Species of interest include Lady's Bedstraw (*Galium verum*), Pyramidal Orchid (*Anacamptis pyramidalis*) and Cowslip (*Primula veris*).
