**Bra155. St Giles's Churchyard, Great Maplestead (0.8 ha) TL 808346**

St Giles's churchyard displays a varied mix of grasses, such as Sweet Vernal Grass (*Anthoxanthum odoratum*), Meadow Foxtail (*Alopecurus pratensis*), Red Fescue (*Festuca rubra*) and Yorkshire Fog (*Holcus lanatus*) and Yellow Oat-grass (*Trisetum flavescens*). Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*), Pignut (*Conopodium majus*), Lady's Bedstraw (*Galium verum*) and Field Wood-rush (*Luzula campestris*) can also be found, along with locally abundant Shining Crane's-bill (*Geranium lucidum*).
