**Bra7. Tom's Lane, (0.8 ha), TL 671327**

The majority of this site is a green lane, but it also includes a small section of grass verge habitat either side of a gravelled track way at the west end. The green lane bridleway has a variety of woody species including Field Maple (*Acer campestre*), Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*), Hazel (*Corylus avellana*), Hawthorn (*Crataegus monogyna*) and Blackthorn (*Prunus spinosa*). The more open areas of the lane at the north east end, allow Cowslip (*Primula veris*) to thrive. The grass verges support a rich flora including Sulphur Clover (*Trifolium ochroleucon*), Lady's Bedstraw (*Galium verum*), Restharrow (*Ononis repens*), Black Knapweed (*Centaurea nigra*) and Wild Basil (*Clinopodium vulgare*).
