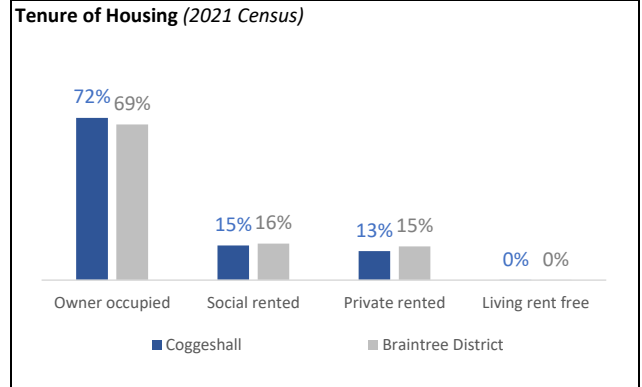
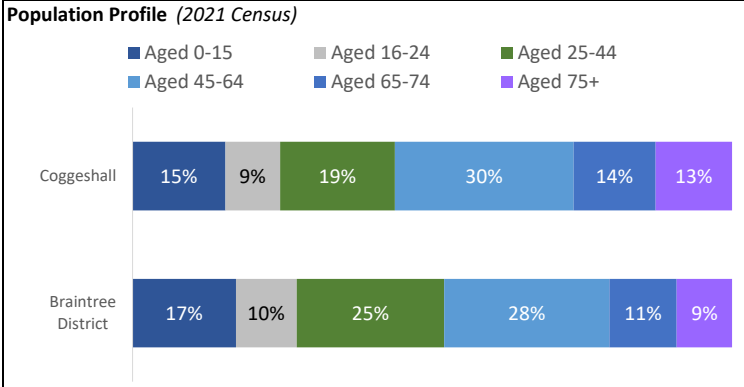

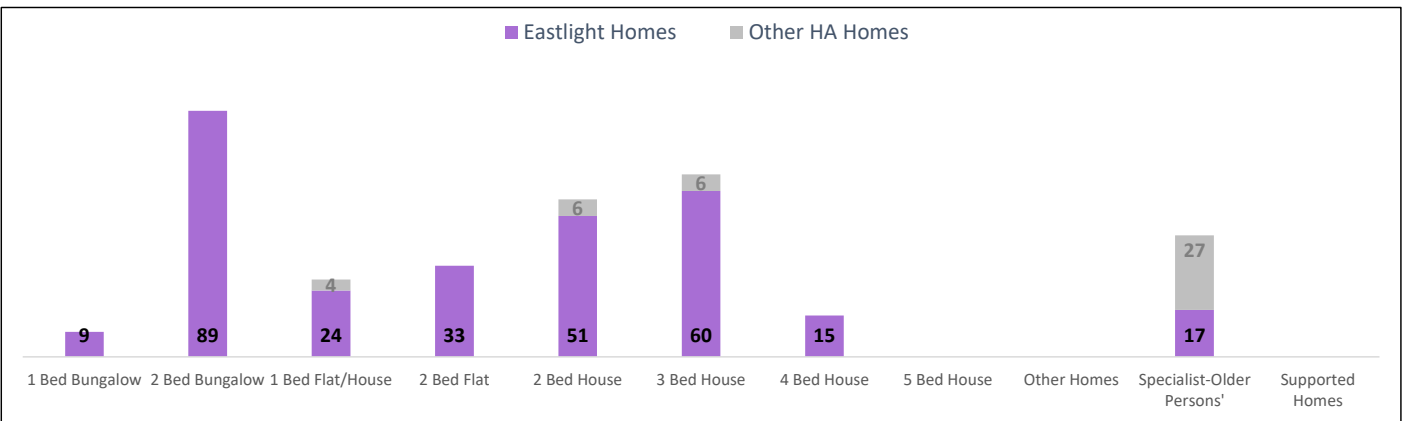

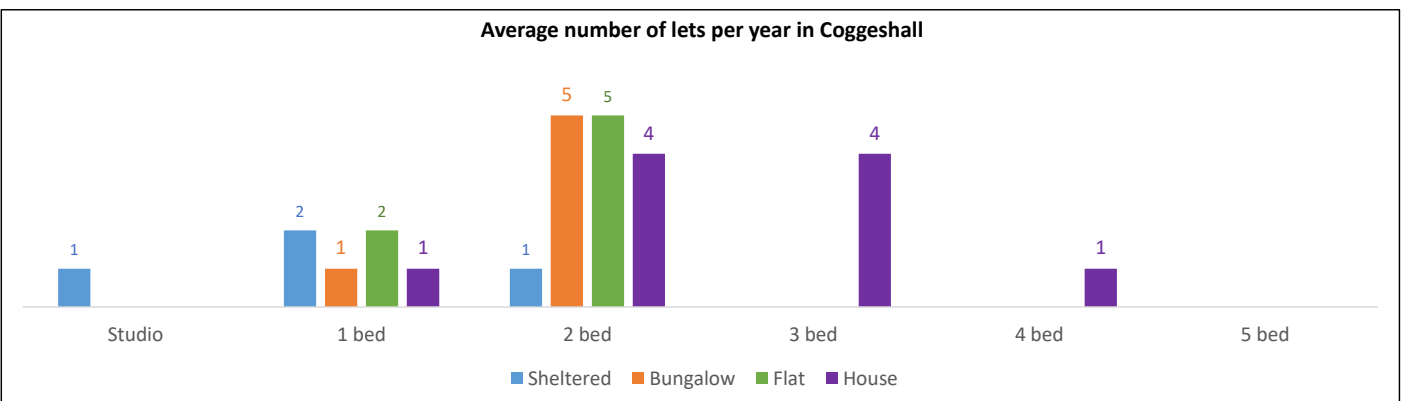

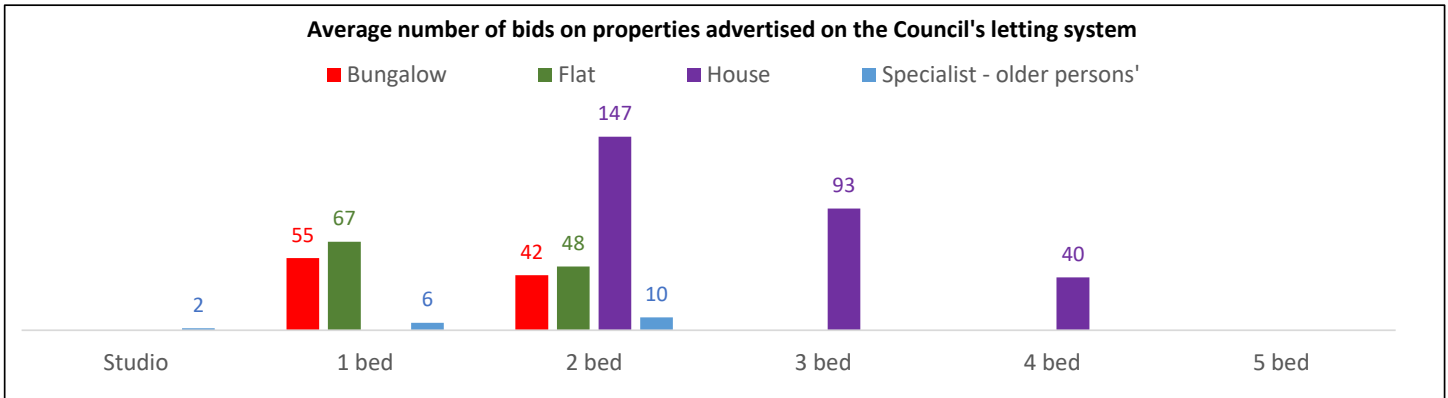
Lettings history in Coggeshall

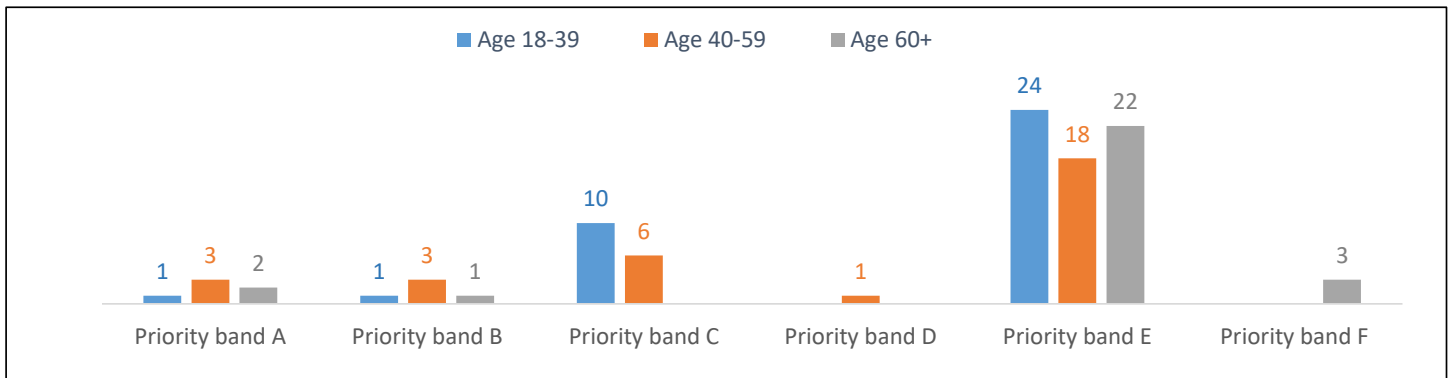
