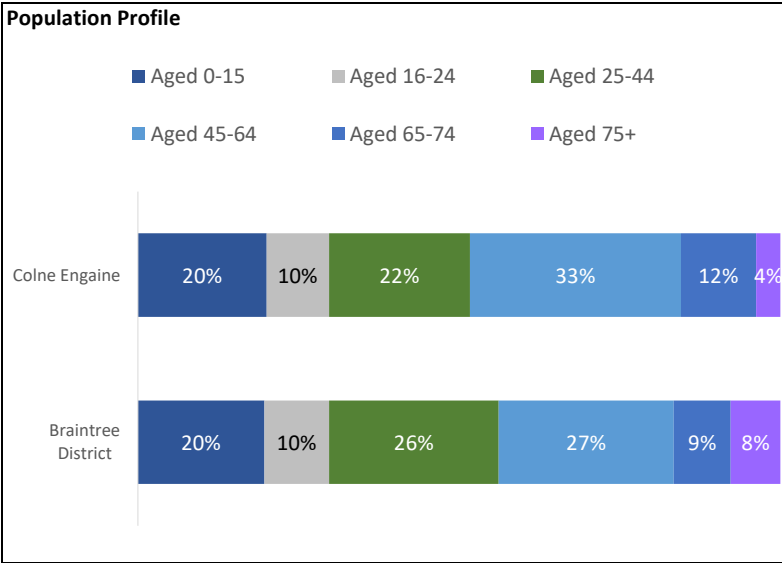

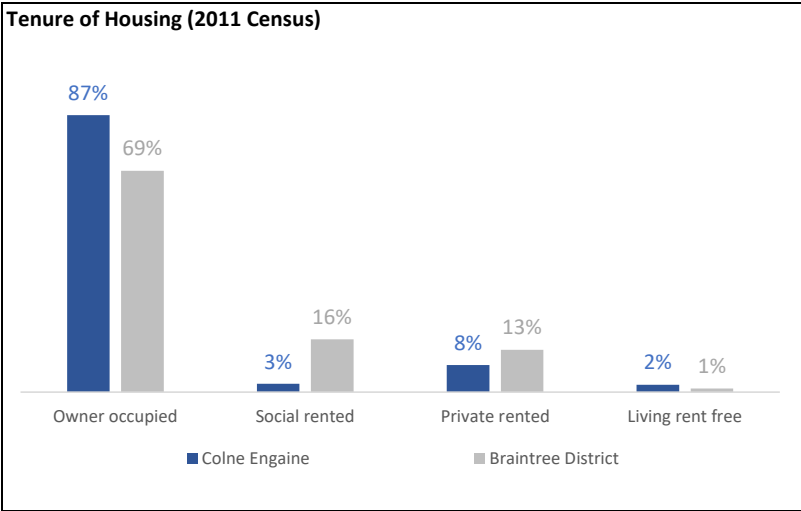


Key Parish Statistics

- Population (2011 Census) - 1,008

- The population is 0.7% of the total Braintree District population (147,084)

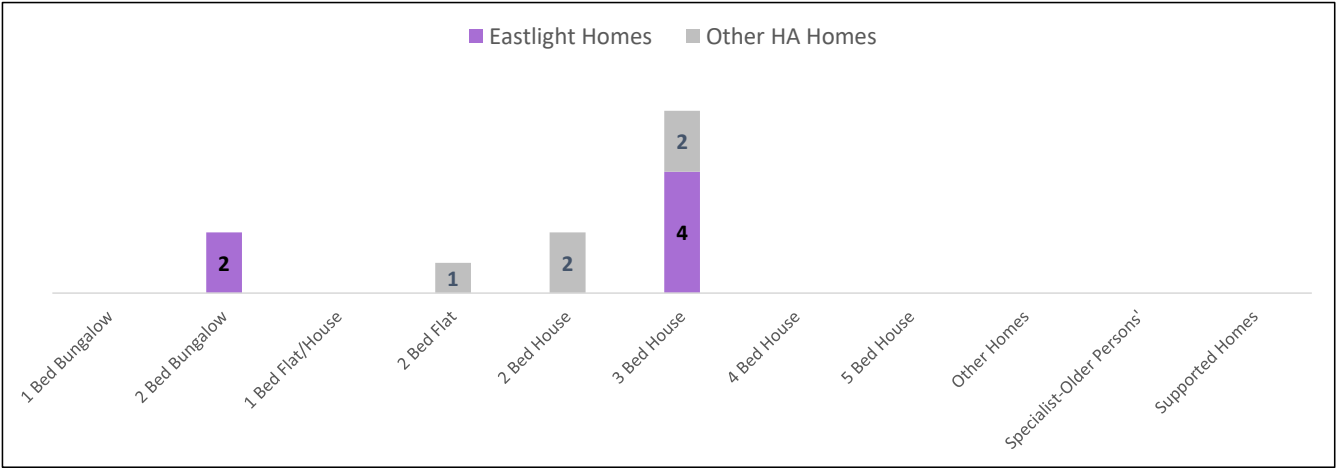
Lower level of employed people actively looking for employment
Just 1% of people aged 16 to 74 were unemployed, which is lower than the District and East of England figure of 4%

Just under a third of households are couples with dependent children
30% of households are couples with dependent children, which is higher than the District proportion of 22%

There were 11 Housing Association homes to rent in Colne Engaine as at July 2023.



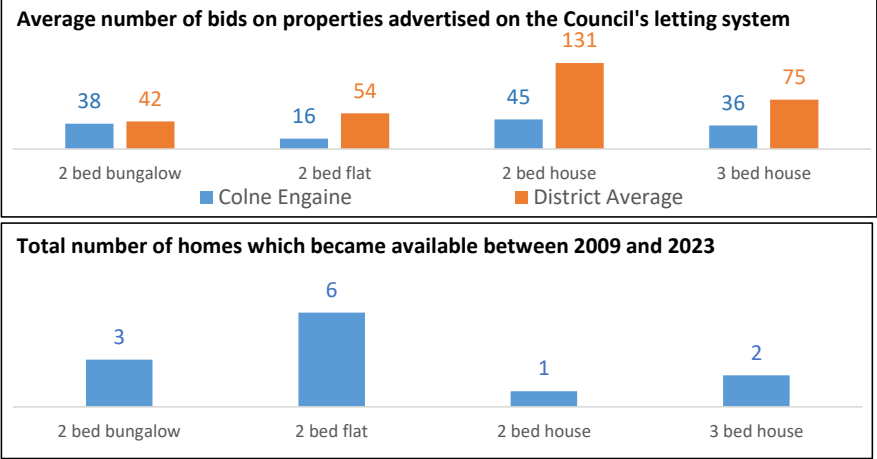
Lettings history in Colne Engaine

During the 14 year period from April 2009 to June 2023, there have been 12 homes that have become available to rent through Gateway to HomeChoice.

These were:

- 1 x 2 bed house
- 2 x 3 bed houses



Applicants waiting for a housing association home to rent

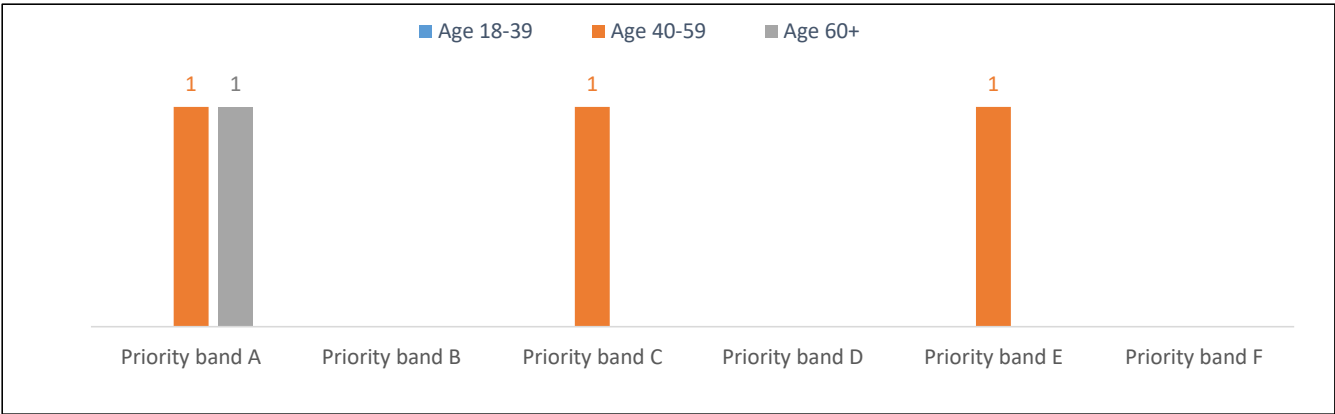
