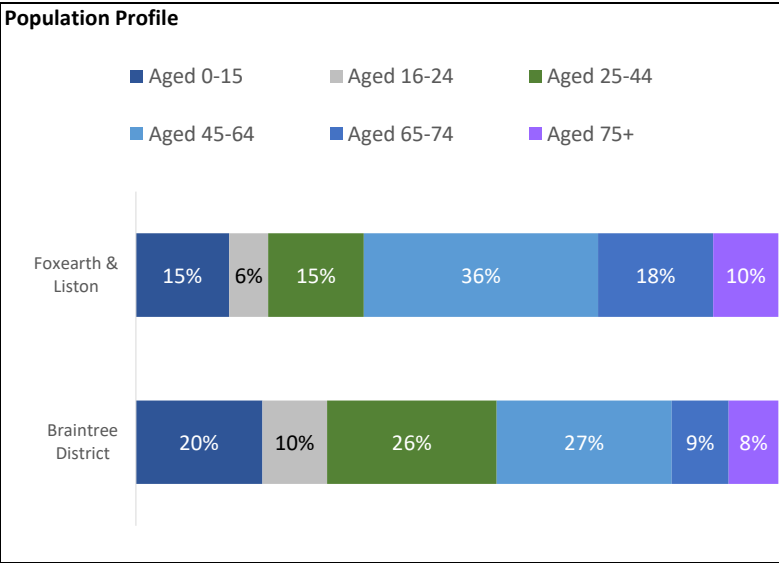

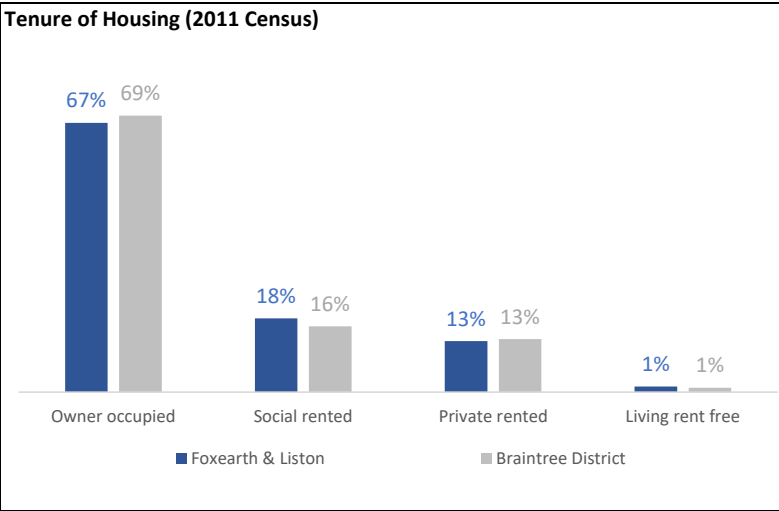


**Key Parish Statistics**

- The population is 0.2% of the total Braintree District population (147,084)

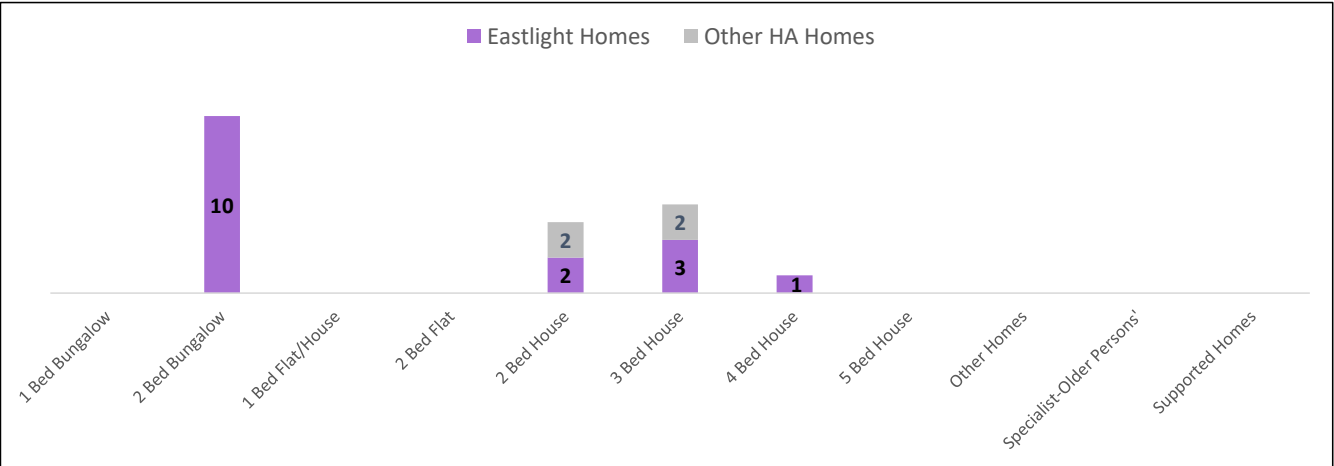
**High proportion of single and couple households over the age of 65**

**Number of homes which have become available to rent**

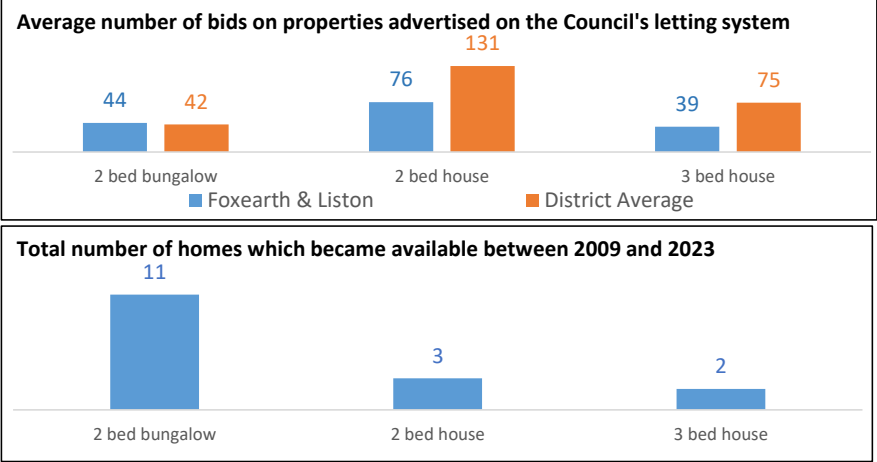
During the 14 year period from April 2009 to June 2023, there have been 16 homes that have become available to rent through Gateway to HomeChoice.

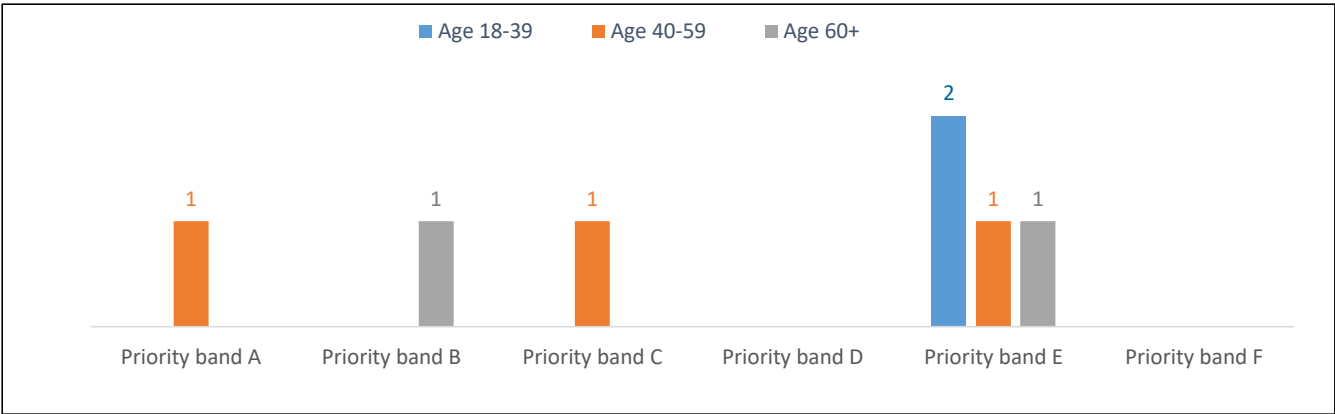
